What is Ortho-K?

Orthokeratology is a non-surgical treatment to reduce nearsightedness. Also known as Ortho-K, it uses specially designed contact lenses to reshape your eye gently, correcting nearsightedness while you sleep. This is accomplished via the use of specialized rigid oxygen-permeable contact lenses or 'retainers' that apply gentle pressure to reshape your cornea so that it bends light correctly.

The most common goal of our patients when they begin Ortho-K is to slow the progression of their myopia. There isn't a treatment to reverse any of the nearsightedness you may have already, however this treatment significantly reduces the continuous progression as you age.

What are the benefits?

Clear vision during the day without the need for glasses or contact lenses, myopia control leading to lower adult prescriptions, and lower likelihood of future physiological issues within the eye.

How is treatment progress monitored?

At each follow up, your eye care specialists will perform a visual acuity and refraction test on your child to ensure vision is acceptable, clear, and the control effect is appropriate.
